LifeGroup Questions:

3. Read **Exodus 6:1-6** and **Acts 6:1-7**. How do these passages influence the way you do seemingly ordinary tasks in a way that reflects God's character?
4. Do you generally think of work as good, neutral, or bad? If we had "sweat glands before the fall," and we see that Adam was given meaningful work, what might that tell us about the way God views work, creativity, and production?
